2022 Winter Registration Fees:

Senior Registration Fee (players turning 18 years + in 2022)	\$250
Junior Registration Fee (players turning 11 - 17 in 2022)	\$220
Net Set Go - GO Competition (players turning 9 & 10 in 2022)	\$220
Net Set Go - Set Competition (players turning 7 & 8 in 2022)	

Club registrations open Monday 3rd January 2022 for returning Saints ONLY and close promptly at midnight on Sunday 9th January 2022.

Payment for fees is to be made via Netball Australia's new operating platform - Player HQ (links for registration provided as part of this email). Payment is required to be made in full at the time of registration.

Net Set Go:

As per the 2021 Winter season, Noranda Netball Association have moved to a Date of Birth registration as opposed to school year registration, therefore Net Set Go is structured as followed:

Net Set Go - SET Division: Players turning 7 & 8 in 2022

Net Set Go - GO Division: Players turning 9 & 10 in 2022

Whilst 'date of birth' registration differs from school enrolments, it is the current requirements of Netball Australia. As a community club, we welcome new players to our club and our inclusive culture embraces the potential changes each season.

Training night: Thursday (Commencement date & time TBA)

Venue: Noranda Netball Courts - Garson Rd, Noranda

Game night: Friday nights. Starting 29/4/22, with the last fixtured game 19/8/22. Times for these games will be 5.15 and 6.15pm. There are 3 Byes (no games played) on Friday 3/6/22, Friday 8/7/22 and Friday 15/7/22.



Sub Junior and Junior Competition:

This is the 'full rules' competition and is for those players:

Sub Junior – Turning 11, 12 & 13 in 2022

Junior – Turning 14, 15, 16 & 17 in 2022

Games are played on Saturday in both the AM and PM time slots. Fixtures and game times will be released on 23rd April in readiness for the competition to begin on Saturday 30th April.

Grading Dates: Players in this competition are graded and attendance at ALL of these days is COMPULSORY. Venue for Grading is Noranda Netball Courts on the following dates:

Sub Juniors: Thursday 24/2, 5pm – 7pm

Juniors: Saturday 19/2 (Player time slot TBA via email)

Saturday 26/2 (Player time slot TBA via email)

Grading is completed based on Coaches feedback on 2021 performance (for existing Saints) in addition to player performance on grading days. As part of the registration process (when you register your player for the 2022 season) players have been asked to nominate 2 playing positions they wish to trial in

Game day: Saturday, commencing 30th April 2022.

There will be 15 rounds with the following dates to be noted: Semi Final: 27th August 2022, Preliminary Final: 3rd September 2022, Grand Final: 10th September 2022.

Senior Competition:

Players turning 18 and over in 2022. Games are played on Saturdays in the AM and PM time slots.

Grading Dates: Players in this competition are graded and attendance at ALL of these days is COMPULSORY. Venue for Grading is at Noranda Netball Association Courts (Garson Rd, Noranda)

Saturday 19/2 (Player time slot TBA via email)

Saturday 26/2 (Player time slot TBA via email)

Netball is a competitive sport from the age of 10 years.

We grade to ensure all players of varying abilities get to play with, and against, players of similar skill level. Teams will play against other competitive and skilled opponents, who have also gone through grading within their club.

Stronger players always enjoy the challenge of harder, faster competition and do not develop to their potential if graded to a lower team just to be kept with a friend. Similarly, players who are placed in teams above their ability will also not develop to their potential when being constantly overshadowed by stronger teammates and opponents.

Players put in this environment may become disheartened and lose self-esteem. All this helps to produce a fairer level of competition, a better fit within a team, more individual confidence and a more constructive learning experience.

Grading is completed based on Coaches feedback on 2021 performance (for existing players) in addition to performance on Grading Days. As part of the registration process (when you register your player for the 2022 season) players have been asked to nominate 2 playing positions they wish to trial in.

The grading committee will assess the skills of a player based on

- Footwork, Speed & Agility
- Ball handling skills
- Attacking/Defending skills
- Sportsmanship & Attitude

If you are unable to attend a grading session you will need to notify the club prior to the day. . A failure to attend all grading sessions will result in placement into a team based upon Paper Grading.

Grading Committee

Our grading committee is selected and sourced each year by the clubs committee. The graders will range from experienced coaches from the Club, external coaches and others who bring knowledge and impartiality.

Parents, please encourage your child to participate at their highest level and be proud to be a Saint, regardless of the team. We are a club made up of many teams, NOT teams made up of many players. The Club wants your child to participate and that it's not about what division they play in, it's about being in a team sport, having fun and learning, but also being able to be competitive against players with a similar skill level.



Pre-Season Training
